Questions for town council meeting, July 13, 2010 at 6:30 p.m.

1. Current conditions of the road. Access to the road is a double blind access meaning that to the north and south there are blind curves with a 20 foot elevation drop in the middle where our road comes off of HWY N.
2. History. Our main concern with the condition of the road is that in the past, the bus has stopped on HWY N and thus created a dangerous highway crossing for the children entering the bus. Our concern is that during dangerous weather conditions (rain, snow, ice) the crossing will be even more dangerous and potentially deadly for drivers or our children.
3. Future. We would be willing to pay to have the road brought to county/town standards but want to know exactly what those standards are. We are also willing to dedicate the road to the town/county. What does that mean for us as a subdivision? If this is not a possibility, what would we need to do in order to allow the bus, garbage, mail to be brought to each home on our road. (We have contacted the Belleville Postmistress who will be coming through and surveying our road in the next week or so. She will contact us as to what she feels.)
4. Bus. Last summer, Mrs. Eicher and some student engineers drove on our road and determined that our road (particularly in the winter) would not allow for the bus to safely maneuver the cul-de-sac. In response to this, there have been numerous delivery trucks, moving vans and semis that have been able to accommodate the circle turn around. If the town does not accept our road, the association will speak to our snow removal company and ensure that the road will be plowed to an acceptable standard for the bus. Also, would the school bus company consider driving on a gravel road until the road is paved?
5. Currently our association is in the process of working with an attorney to reclaim land (including the road parcel) that has been on a federal government tax lien per Ron Rosslein.
